a) Consent Agenda items:

- i) Approval of the Clifton Chamber of Commerce’s “Bosque Tour de Norway” Bike Rally on May 14, 2016 requiring barricades along North Avenue Q and FM 219 for temporary intersection traffic control.
- ii) Approval of Main Street’s request for street closure of City Park, Riverside and the city’s portion of FM 3220 on Saturday, June 4, 2016 from 7:30 pm to 10:00 pm. for the Legacy Park Glow Run, same route as the last two years.
- iii) Approval of Main Street’s request for street closure of FM 219, 100 & 200 blocks of Avenue D & E from 9:00 – 9:30 am on June 3, 2016 while the Marine Combat Outdoors, Ft Hood 1<sup>st</sup> Calvary Mounted division and a large motorcade come through during this time along with a parade for the veterans.
- iv) Adopting a proclamation requested by the Heart of Texas RSVP proclaiming April 5, 2016 as National Service Recognition Day.
- v) Adopting a proclamation to declare the week of April 10-16, 2016 to be Clifton Volunteer Appreciation Week.
- vi) Adopting a proclamation requested by the North Texas Chapter of The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society designating September 2016 as Blood Cancer Awareness Month.
